Discipleship

A Discipleship System provides a path that moves a disciple from the world, into the church and onward to spiritual growth and development.

Spiritual growth and development in Christ is a dynamic process marked by awakening, birth, growth, and maturation. This process requires careful and intentional nurturing for the disciple to reach perfection in the Christian life.

Fully utilizing a Discipleship System is a major change for most churches because they use a more traditional approach where believers invite the people to come to the church to hear the gospel. The focus is on the event of worship in the church rather than on the process of discipleship within a network of people.

In churches based on Discipleship Systems, followers of Jesus go into the world taking the gospel to the people, and then bring new believers into the church for further growth and development.
