thing to be grasped,

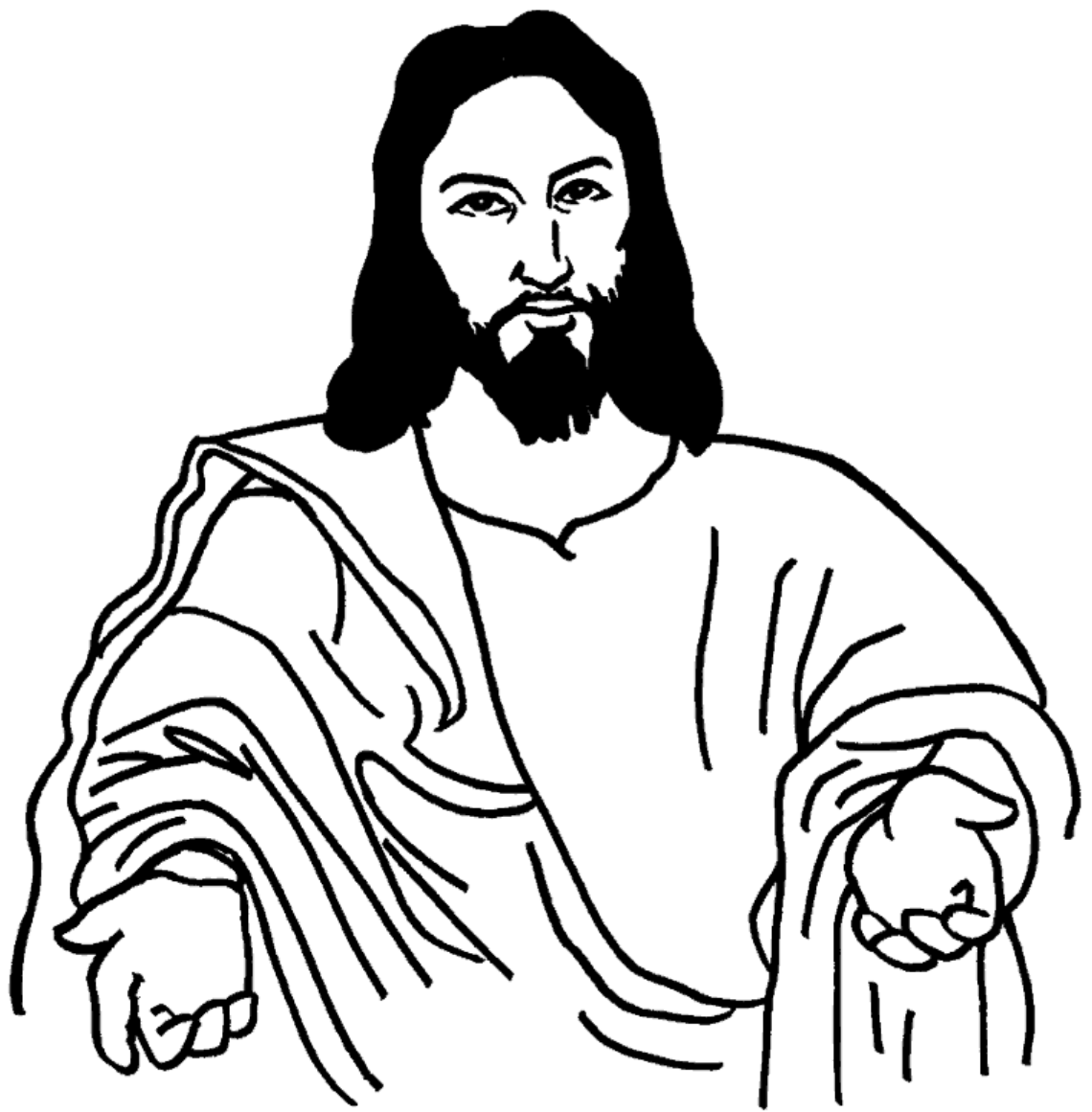




Phil 2:7 but

name which is above every name,

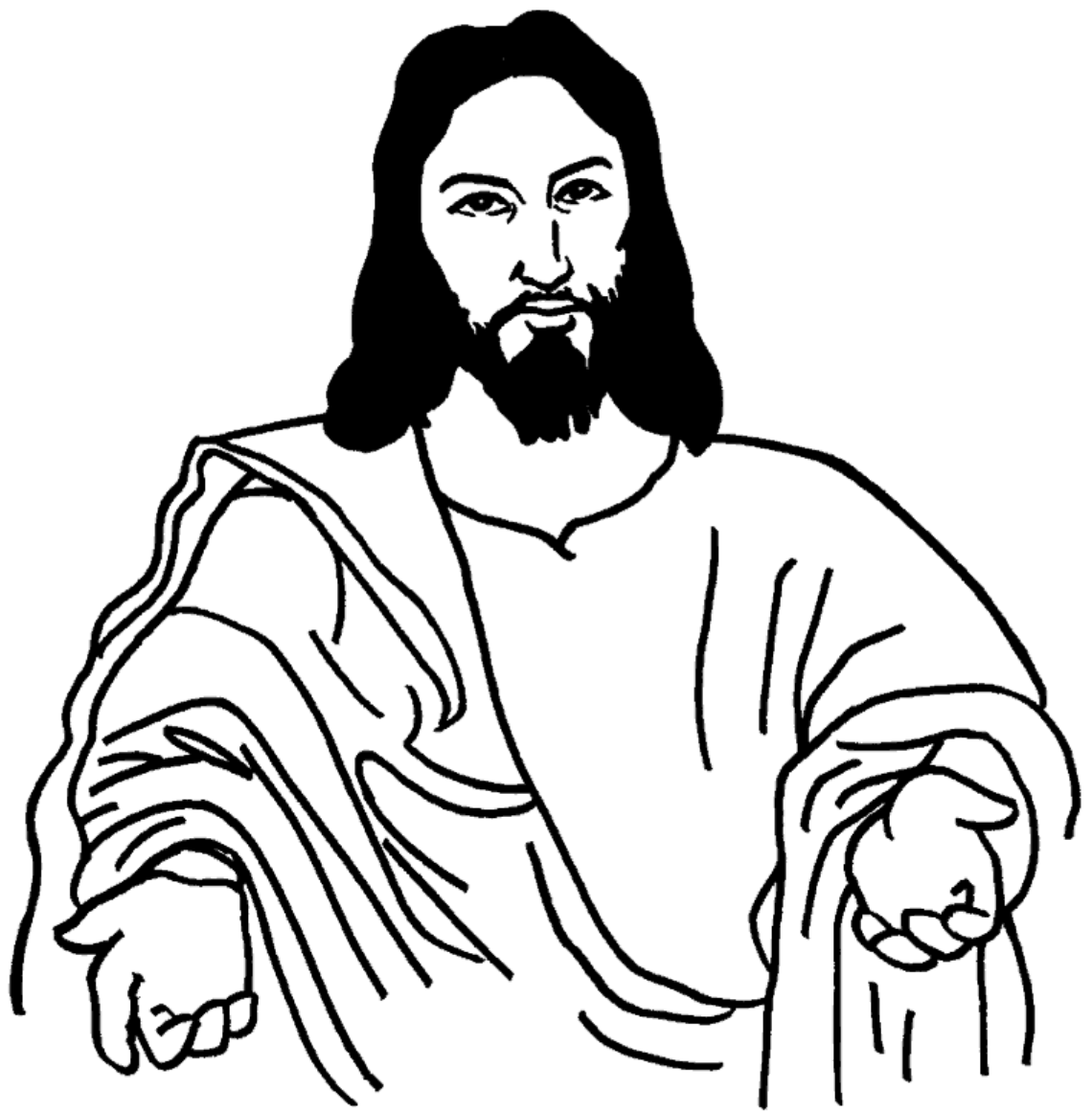


that at the name of Jesus every

Perfect man:


Luke 6:40 A
