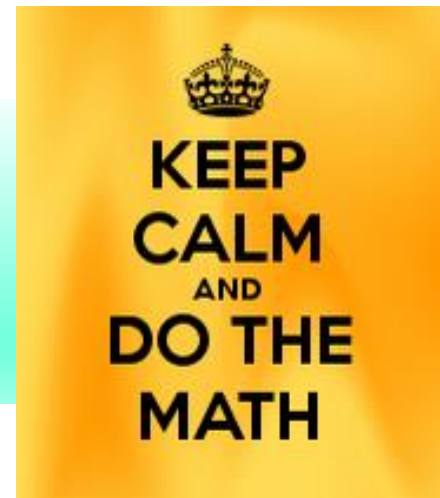

Mat 6:31 Therefore *do not be anxious*, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?'

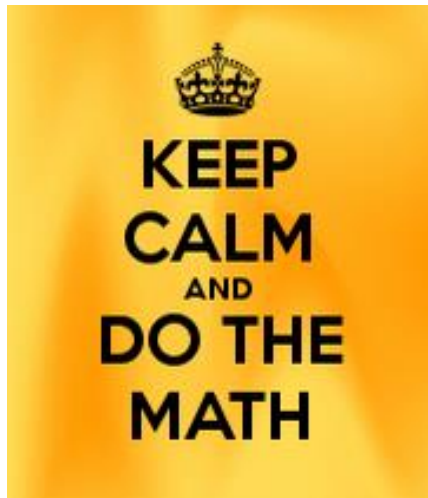


Give us this day
